

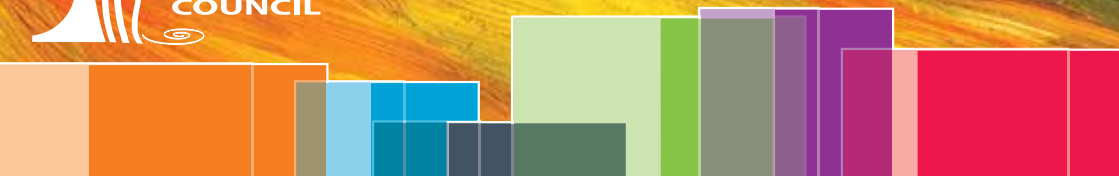

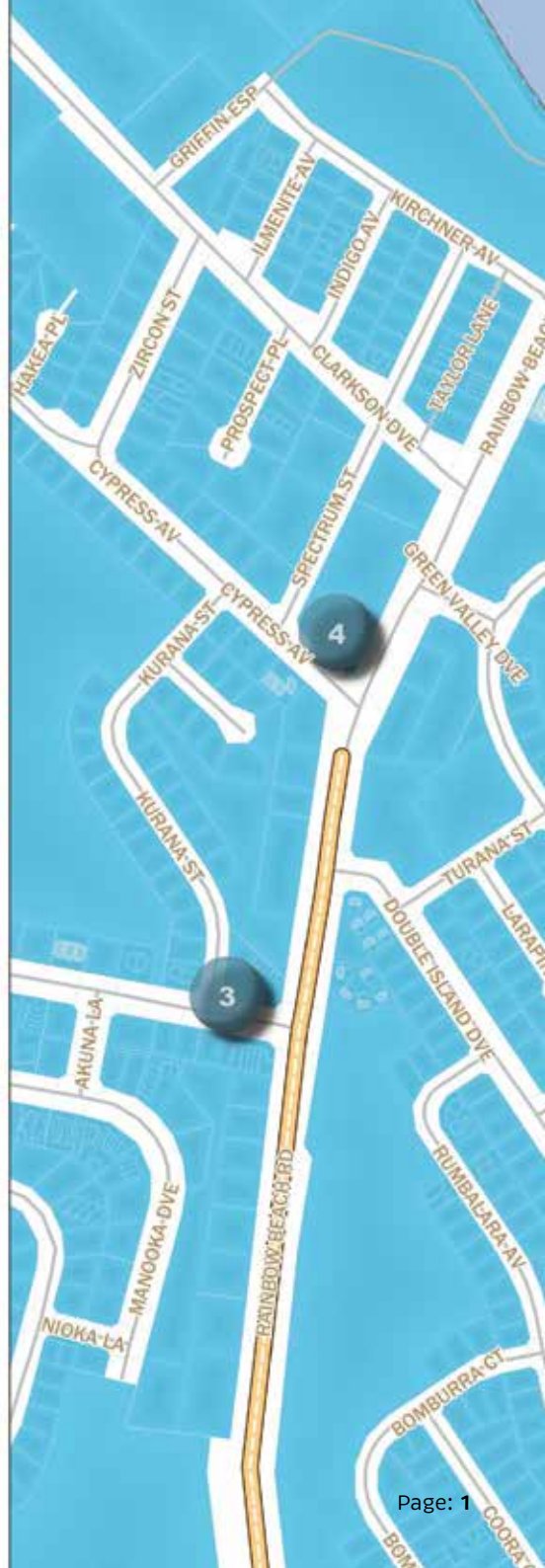

‘I love being near the coast and capturing the lifestyle and the feeling of the local area in my work.’

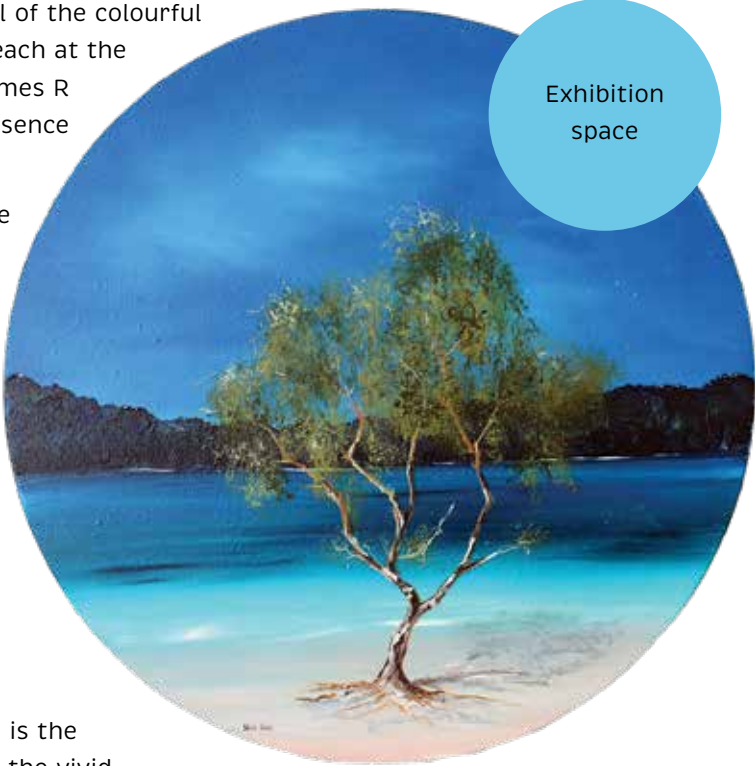
Step inside Rainbow Beach Pizza and view a collection of works from local artist Lynette Dimmock of Net Rae Art.

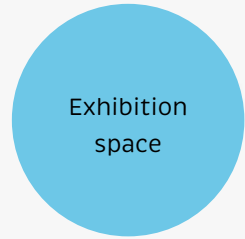

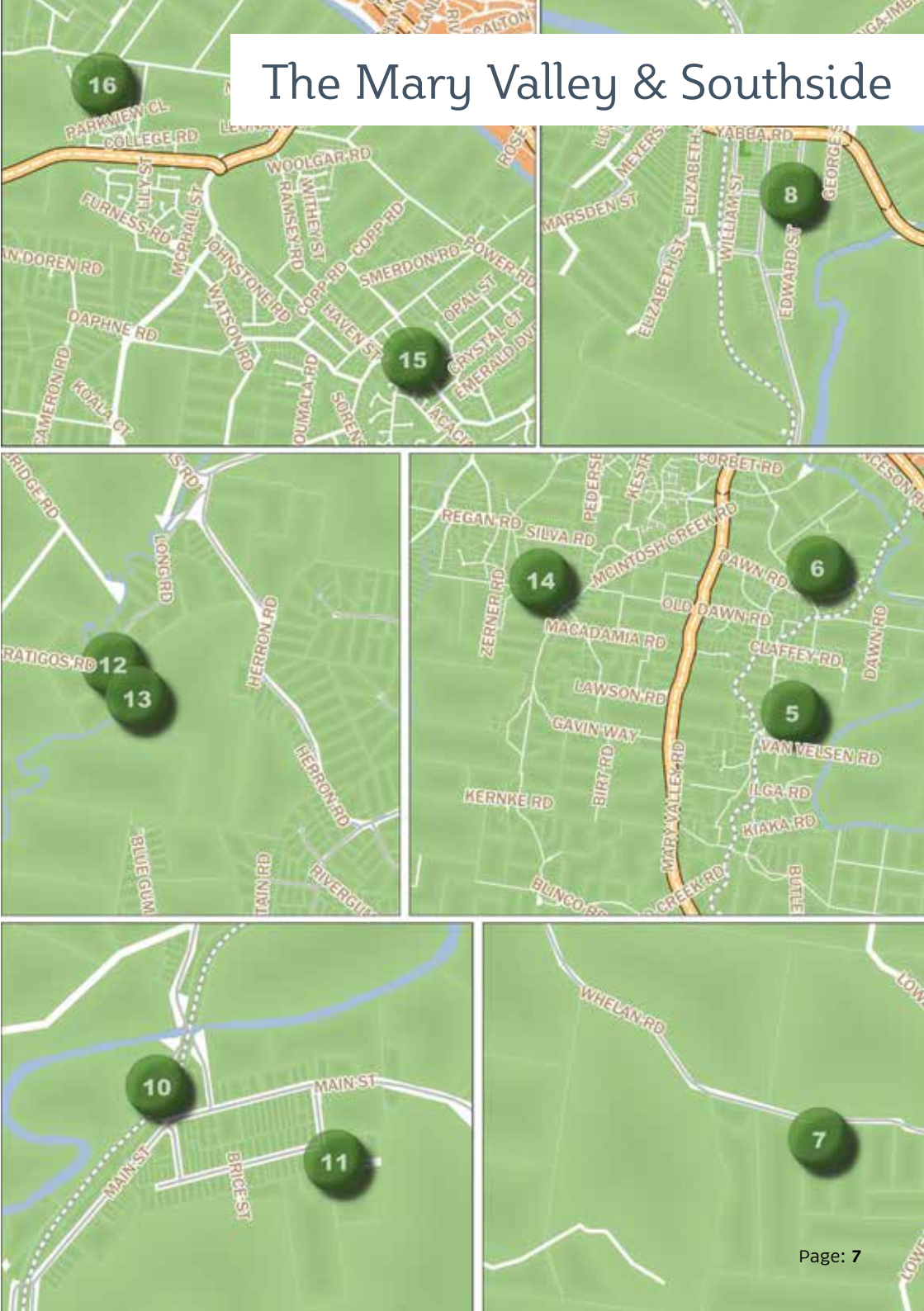

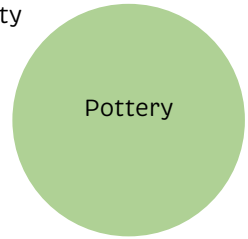

Set in the beautiful Mary Valley, sustainability and practicality are at the heart of this studio’s operations. Artist Paul Johnson makes his own glazes from the wood ash in his fireplace to create his unique colours fired in kilns powered by solar panels. ‘I make functional ware such as coffee mugs, bowls, dinner plates and one-of-a-kind raku fired pots pieces.’



Influenced by his environment, Paul’s pottery regularly features leaves and plants, but his style can vary from designs painted in glaze to intricately carved work.

Paul offers classes for people keen to learn how to ‘throw’ a pot on the wheel.

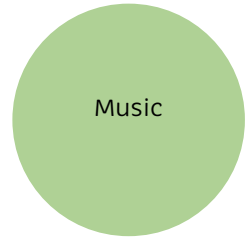

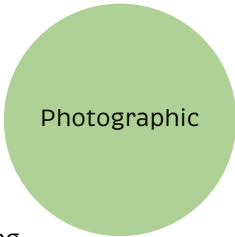

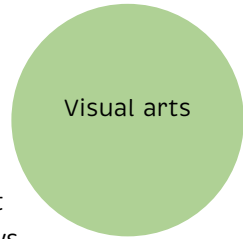
11. Lizzie Connor Fine Art Studio

The driving force behind Art + Art in Goomeri are local artists Angela Pude and Julie Trott.

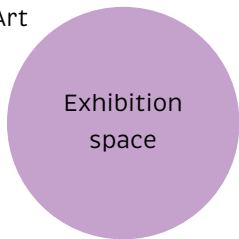
