3. Gympie Regional Council shall have the right, at its sole discretion and at any time, to change or modify these terms and conditions. Such change shall be effective immediately upon posting to council's website.
4. Gympie Regional Council reserves the right to cancel the competition if circumstances arise outside of its control.
5. Gympie Regional Council's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. Participation in this promotion deems acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

Who can enter

7. Entrants must be aged between 12 and 17 years.
8. Only one submission per child will be accepted.

Condition of Work

9. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and not won a prize in any other art competition.
10. All work must be unframed. We encourage work to be delivered in a plastic sleeve or between cardboard for the safety of the work.
11. Work can be in any 2D medium and must relate to the theme 'Easter'.
12. Each work must be submitted with this form, and have the owner's name, artwork title and contact number clearly printed on the back of the entry.

How to Enter

13. Competition period: submissions must be submitted by Saturday, 1 April 2023 to be eligible to enter. Late entries - i.e. those hard copies received after Saturday, 1 April 2023 will not be accepted and are ineligible.
14. Entries must be submitted to:
 - Gympie Regional Gallery: 39 Nash Street, Gympie.
 - Gympie Regional Libraries: Tin Can Bay, Rainbow Beach, Imbil, Goomeri, Kilkivan and Gympie.

Prizes

15. The winners will be announced at the Easter on Mary event (5 April 2023) and will receive a follow up email and have until 5pm on Friday, 5 May 2023 to collect their prize from a location nominated by Gympie Regional Council, disclosed in the email.
