



Over the five years to 2022/23, the Knowledge Industries and Professional Services Sector in the Gympie Region was estimated to have averaged 1.1% p.a. growth in jobs and -0.2% p.a. change in value added suggesting higher productivity. Both growth rates were below the State average.







In 2021 in the Gympie Region, 39.6% of **Knowledge Industries and Professional** Services workers were professionals, compared to 48.4% in Queensland.


